What is a sculpture?

Sculptors make three dimensional artworks.

To make a sculpture, you can use different techniques, such as carving wood, or casting metal.

Sculptures can be made from many different materials, such as bronze, stone, marble, wood and more.



This is a man named Marc Quinn and he is famous for his sculpting skills. Marc Quinn is a British Artist, who was born in London in 1964.

His sculptures, paintings and drawings explore the link between art and science.

He often uses unusual materials in his sculptures, such as ice.

BREAD!

Bread can be used to make lots of different sculptures, like the pictures on the next page.

Today's task:

To create your own sculpture using bread.

You will need to think carefully about what you want to sculpt. What shapes will you need? What size is it going to be?

Using bread dough, make your own sculpture. You may need to use some tools to help you cut parts out and shape things together. You may want to include some patterns too.
